Moses Illustrates How Godly Priorities Lead to Right Choices and Assure Lasting Rewards

- I. Godly priorities start with wise parents (v. 23)
 - 1. Moses' parents saw he was "no ordinary child." (Acts 7:23-25)
 - 2. What do you see in your child? (Matthew 6:33)
 - 3. Remember wise parents model and teach godly priorities.
- II. Godly priorities enable us to make the hard choices. (VV. 24-25)
 - 1. Saying no to what looks good now (v. 24)
 - 2. Saying yes to what looks good later (v. 25)
 - 3. What generation are you?
- III. Godly priorities enable us to clearly see the results of our choices. (v. 26)
 - 1. A Key Question: How will this decision look in *eternity*?
 - 2. Some Key Words:
 - "regarded"
 - "looking ahead"
