Jesus' attention to the widow's offering teaches us about giving and about life.

- 1. Three simple lessons:
 - Everyone can and should give. (v. 42)
 - Faith-based giving is enabling. (v. 43)
 - God celebrates big gifts. (v. 44)
- 2. When faced with a choice, choose both. (v. 42)
- 3. What is God's perspective on giving? (v. 44)
 - · What's left is more important than what's given.
 - Proportion is more important than size.
 - Commitment is more important than quantity.
- 4. What does this mean for me and Bible Center Church?
 - The main point is *not*: Even **small** gifts mean a lot.
 - The main point is: Proportionally big gifts mean a lot.
