James 4:13-17

At the beginning of verse 13, James captures our attention with a call to pay attention.

1. A Warning (v. <u>13</u>)

- A. James is writing to believers that are completely excluding God from planning their lives.
- B. Inviting God into your decision-making, planning, and strategizing is important.
- C. The mindset of arrogant autonomy gives a person the illusion of control. (v. 14; James 3:5-6; Proverbs 3:5-8)

2. A Reminder (vv. <u>14-15</u>)

- A. This is a reminder that our lives are short; we are like a vapor that vanishes. (James 1:16-17)
- B. This is also a reminder to use humility when approaching planning out our lives. (v. 15; Matthew 6:9-10, 33-34)

3. An Encouragement (vv. 16-17)

- A. To be clear, the occupation of the people James is correcting isn't wrong, their hearts are.
- B. The encouragement here is to do the good we know we should.

Our Response:

- 1. Make room for God.
- 2. Make room for others.
