Spiritual Gifts

Administration

I organize people and details to accomplish tasks.

Apostleship

I start new things to reach more people for Jesus.

Craftsmanship

Discernment

Encouragement

I strengthen, comfort, or urge others to action through the Word.

Evangelism

I find ways to serve and support others.

Hospitality

I create warm and welcoming environments for others.

Intercession

I frequently and consistently pray for the people and things in my life.

Knowledge

I seek to learn as much as possible about the Bible.

Leadership

I have the ability to influence people to direct and focus them on the big picture.

Mercy

I feel empathy and care for those who are hurting in any way.

Prophecy

I communicate God's truth and call people to right actions.

Shepherd

I care for the spiritual and physical needs of others.

Teaching

I study Scripture and can help make it understandable and applicable to others.

Wisdom

Others often ask me for my advice and thoughts in difficult matters.



Passions

Family Ministries: Assist our High School, Middle School, Children's, or Early Childhood Staff by serving or teaching.

City Ministries: Volunteer in various ways to love and serve the less fortunate, homeless, recovering, or hurting. Work and pray for the renewal and flourishing of our community.

Global Outreach Ministries: Use your gifts around the globe, write to our Global Partners, or help with Bible Center's Mission Sundays.

The Maker's Center: Encourage, and love the hurting on Charleston's West Side.

Life Group Ministries: Help host, lead, teach, or facilitate a group of believers.
